**Tonight's Start:** 20-year-old right-hander **Bryse Wilson** makes his third Triple-A start in the finale of this three-game series vs. Louisville. It is his 58<sup>th</sup> career Minor League appearance (55<sup>th</sup> start).

<u>Prospect Watch:</u> Wilson is currently rated the Atlanta Braves' No. 13 prospect by MLB.com. He was also rated the Braves' No. 12 prospect by Baseball America entering the 2018 season.

**<u>Vs. Louisville:</u>** Making his third International League start, Wilson faces the Louisville Bats for the first time in his career tonight.

Last Start: Wilson picked up his second win in as many starts for the Stripers on 8/9 at Buffalo, going 6.2 innings (7 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 3 SO). He exited with an 8-4 lead, and Gwinnett went on to win 9-5. Luis Marte had four hits and Alex Jackson hit a two-run homer as part of an 18-hit attack.

**2018 Season:** Wilson is 7-5 with a 3.50 ERA (45 ER in 115.2 IP) over 22 starts between Advanced-A Florida, Double-A Mississippi and Gwinnett. **He ranks second in the Braves' system in strikeouts (126) and ninth in ERA**.

• <u>With Florida</u>: He opened the season with the Fire Frogs and was nearly untouchable, going 2-0 with a 0.34 ERA, .167 BAA and 0.86 WHIP in five starts from 4/10-5/2. Wilson was named Florida's April Pitcher of the Month by Atlanta (2-0, 0.45 ERA, .178 BAA in 4 starts).

<u>With Mississippi</u>: In 15 starts with the M-Braves, Wilson went 3-5 with a 3.97 ERA (34 ER in 77.0 IP), .258 BAA (77-for-298, 3 HR) and 1.34 WHIP. He was 2-0 with a 0.84 ERA, .177 BAA and 42 strikeouts over five starts in July, earning Mississippi's Pitcher of the Month award.

■ <u>SL Pitcher of the Week</u>: Wilson was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on 7/8 (1-0, 0.00 ERA, 0 ER in 13.1 IP, 1 BB, 16 SO in 2 starts).

Young Gun: On 8/4 vs. Norfolk, Wilson (20 years, 7 months, 15 days) became the second-youngest starting pitcher in Gwinnett's 10-year history, older than only Julio Teheran (20 years, 2 months, 12 days on 4/8/11 vs. Durham).

About 2017: In his first full season, Wilson went 10-7 with a 2.50 ERA (38 ER in 137.0 IP) and one shutout over 26 starts with Class-A Rome. He was named Rome's Pitcher of the Year by the Atlanta Braves.

<u>Organization Ranks</u>: He ranked among Braves MiLB leaders in ERA (1<sup>st</sup>,

2.50), wins (3<sup>rd</sup>, 10), strikeouts (5<sup>th</sup>, 139) and innings (6<sup>th</sup>, 137.0).

• <u>All-Star Accolades:</u> He was named both a Midseason and Postseason All-Star in the South Atlantic League, as well as a Braves' Organization All-Star by MiLB.com and Low Class-A All-Star by *Baseball America*.

• <u>SAL Pitcher of the Week:</u> He earned his first career Pitcher of the Week award in the South Atlantic League, winning for 7/3-7/9 after throwing his first career CG shutout (9.0 IP, 5 H, 0 BB, 7 SO) on 7/8 vs. West Virginia.

**Career Highlights:** Entering 2018, Wilson was 11-8 with a 2.20 ERA (40 ER in 163.2 IP) in 35 career MiLB games (32 starts) over two seasons.

 <u>2016</u>: Selected by the Atlanta Braves in the fourth round out of Orange (NC) High School. Went 1-1 with a 0.68 ERA (2 ER in 26.2 IP) and a .172 BAA in nine games (6 starts) on his professional debut with the GCL Braves.
